Clay Young from SCE&G presented an update of FERC approval of the SCRTP implementation of FERC Order 1000. Mr. Young also gave an overview of the regional and planning processes of the Southeastern Regional Transmission Planning (SERTP) group and compared it to that of the SCRTP.

A presentation on multi-party assessment studies by the Carolinas Transmission Coordination Arrangement, SERC, and the Eastern Interconnection Reliability Assessment Group (ERAG, and other studies), and an update on the EIPC Steady State Load Flow Working Group was given by Diana Scott from Santee Cooper.
